
Coach renewal

Court booking System

Exciting news.

Book a Court online for the Pines Tennis Club is now implemented. It is linked to our bank account so that people can pay online for casual court hire. When you book a court you will be issued with a pin that will active for the period of the booking. (i.e. will open the front gate and club house door from 10 minutes prior to the booking to 10 minutes after the booking has finished.)

Some points to note:

Membership details need to be kept up to date as much as possible so that members booking a court will not be charged.

Court bookings for Gala, Pennant, Coaching, Junior Tournament and Carnivale have been put in the system.

At the moment Robert Jamieson, Graeme and Kerry Scarlett are system administrators and can make recurring bookings.

Our website has been updated so that there is a link from the "Court Hire" screen to the booking application. If you find any unexpected issues with the system please let us know.

There is also a "Book a Court Online" button on the front page of our website where you will be asked to sign in, or register if it is your first time.
